

FEES OVERVIEW

Below are the government-funded childcare fees. At Lilliput Day Nursery, we apply an additional fee that covers the full range of services we provide. The figures shown here – including our Additional Fees – are reflected in the monthly costs listed below and are calculated on an annual basis, assuming 51 weeks of attendance. Nursery day 8am-6pm.

Tax Free Childcare

You can get up to £500 every 3 months (up to £2,000 a year) for each of your children to help with the costs of childcare. This goes up to £1,000 every 3 months if a child has additional needs (up to £4,000 a year).

Additional Extras

Ad hoc session- Full day- £80
Welcome package- £100 or £50 if booking made within 48hrs

We offer a 5% sibling discount, applied to the eldest child's invoice. We also provide a small number of supported places for families on low incomes or experiencing financial difficulty

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND FAQ'S

For Working families with children 9 months plus.

For families of children 9 Months + The term after your child turns 9 months you may be eligible for 30 hours per week, which if using over the full term is stretched over 51 weeks giving you 22.25hrs per week.

For all Children 3-4 year olds

Age 3-4 Years- Funded 38 Weeks 15 Hours
Funded 51 Weeks 11 Hour

Children Age 3-4- Years working families
- Funded 38 Weeks 30 Hours
- Funded 51 Weeks 22,25 Hours

For Children Aged 2 Years and Those Receiving Additional Government Support

Age: 2 Years
Funded 38 Weeks: 15 Hours
Funded 51 Weeks (Stretched Offer): 11 Hours

To access 15 hours of funded early education for your two-year-old, you must meet the government's eligibility criteria. Please visit GOV.UK for full details.

If you are eligible, you are entitled to:

- 15 hours of childcare or early education for 38 weeks of the year (up to 570 hours annually)
- The option to use these hours flexibly with one or more providers
- The option to stretch your hours over 51 weeks, which provides 11 funded hours per week

Frequently Asked Questions

Which term will my child start in based on their birthday?

Birthday- 1st Apr - 31st Aug - Term 1st Sept (Summer)
1st Sep- 31st Dec - Term 1st Jan (Autumn)
1st Jan- 30th April - Term 1st April (Spring)

What is covered by the Government Funding?

Government funding only pays for basic childcare. It does not cover meals, activities, resources or the enriched experiences we provide.

Because of this, we charge an Additional Funding Fee for each funded hour.

This helps pay for an exhaustive list of extra's, below is just a sample,

- Nappies, wipes, sun cream
 - Meals and snacks
- Quality learning resources
 - Staff training
- Trips and experiences

Our fees are calculated monthly, keeping your fees the same each month.
